We provide this data privacy statement to explain our practices regarding the collection, use, disclosure, and protection of information that apply to our Service, as well as your choices regarding the collection and use of information. By using our Service, you consent to the data practices prescribed in this statement.

Data security officer is Christian Richard Plaschy ("ChrisRich"), born on March 13, 1978, from Hombrechtikon, in Zug.

Your privacy and security are of great importance to us. We are focused on giving you the best possible experience, without compromising the information you are sharing with us by using our services. You should read this policy in full, but here is a short summary of the most important points:

We are collecting your data to provide access, improve, understand, customize, support and market our services. To provide access to our services you are creating an account with us and are sharing your username, and e-mail address which will only be saved encrypted. Your e-mail address is used for account recovery purposes, as well as support and notifications.

By using our services we receive some personal information automatically from you such as your IP address and the type of the device you are using.

With your consent we may offer you personalized content such as ads or in-game features. Our services provide an opt-out from the above either through your account settings or through our support.

We are using third party analytics solutions such as "Google Analytics" to improve our services and offer you a better experience.

What Information Is Collected? Personal Information: We collect Personally Identifiable Information (as defined below) only when you provide such information directly to us in connection with the Service.

We ask for Personally Identifiable Information when you register for a User account with the Service, or if you correspond with us (in which case we will also retain our responses).

We store the content and information you explicitly provide when using our services. This can include chat messages, forum messages, comments, messages between users, profile pictures or avatars, and similar data.

We may receive Personally Identifiable Information about you from third parties. For example, if you access our websites or Service through a third-party connection or log-in, for example, through Facebook Connect, etc., that third party may pass certain information about your use of its Service to PLASCHY MUSIC. This information could include any information that you have permitted the third party to share with us, and any information you have made public in connection with that Service. You should always review, and if necessary, adjust your privacy settings on third-party websites and Services before linking or connecting them to our websites or Service. "Personally Identifiable Information" means any information that may be used to identify an individual, including, but not limited to, a first and last name, an e-mail address or other contact information. Non-Personally Identifiable Information: We also collect and use information about your interactions with the Service in a manner and format that does not identify you as an individual ("Non-Personally Identifiable Information"). Analytics information: We use third-party analytics tools to help us measure traffic and usage trends for the Service. These tools collect information sent by your browser as part of a web page request, including the web pages you visit, your browser add-ons, your browser's width and height, and other information that assists us in improving the Service. We may collect and use this analytics information together with your Personally Identifiable Information to build a broader profile of our individual Users so that we can serve you better.

Cookies information: When you visit the Service, we may send one or more cookies - a small text file containing a string of alphanumeric characters - to your computer that uniquely identifies your browser and lets PLASCHY MUSIC help you log in faster and enhance your navigation through the site. A cookie may also convey information to us about how you use the Service (e.g., the pages you view, the links you click and other actions you take on the Service), and allow us or our business partners to track your usage of the Service over time. A persistent cookie remains on your hard drive after you close your browser. Persistent cookies may be used by your browser on subsequent visits to the site. Persistent cookies can be removed by following your web browser's directions. A session cookie is temporary and disappears after you close your browser. You can reset your web browser to refuse all cookies or to indicate when a cookie is being sent. However, some features of the Service may not function properly if the ability to accept cookies is disabled.

Log file information: Log file information is automatically reported by your browser each time you access a web page. When you use our Service, our servers automatically record certain log file information. These server logs may include anonymous information such as your web request, Internet Protocol ("IP") address, browser type, referring / exit pages and URLs, number of clicks and how you interact

How Is Such Information Used? We use your information to provide you access to our services, to ensure their proper function, to enrich your user experience and deliver the best quality we are capable of, as well as improving our marketing efforts and business model.

Personally Identifiable Information: We may use the Personally Identifiable Information we collect or receive to communicate directly with you. We may occasionally send e-mails to you regarding updates about technology, announce new features, remind you of events, or inform you about other important news. We also use your Personally Identifiable Information to send you Service-related e-mails (e.g., account verification, changes/updates to features of the Service, technical and security notices). You may not opt out of Service-related emails. You always have the option to unsubscribe to these messages.

Non-Personally Identifiable Information: We use or may use cookies, log file, and clear gifs information to: (a) remember information so that you will not have to re-enter it during your visit or the next time you visit the site; (b) provide custom, personalized content and information; (c) to provide and monitor the effectiveness of our Service; (d) monitor aggregate metrics such as total number of visitors, traffic, and demographic patterns; (e) diagnose or fix technology problems; (f) help you efficiently access your information after you sign in; and (g) to provide advertising to your browser or device.

Is The Information Shared Or Disclosed? When you register for our services, we create a basic profile which is available to other users. Information shared may include your username and/or first/second name, country as well as additional information you explicitly provide yourself for sharing with other users. Additionally with the usage of our services data such as rankings, points, experience, and similar may be shared with other users viewing your profile.

Who we may share your Personally Identifiable Information with: We may share your Personally Identifiable Information with third-party business partners for the purpose of providing the Service to you (e.g. e-mail providers, server providers etc.). Those business partners will be given limited access to the Personally Identifiable Information that is reasonably necessary to deliver the Service, and we will require that such third parties comply with this Data privacy statement.

Who you may choose to share your Personally Identifiable Information with: Any Personal Identifiable Information or content that you voluntarily disclose for posting to the Service, such as User Content, becomes available to the public. If you remove information that you posted to the Service, copies may remain viewable in cached and archived pages of the Service, or if other Users have copied or saved that information. We may use a third-party Service provider to manage payment processing. By using paid aspects of the Service, you agree to share your billing and other payment information with any such third-party payment processor for the purpose of processing your payments.

What happens to your Personally Identifiable Information in the event of a change of control: We may buy or sell/divest the company, or any combination of its products, Services, assets and/or businesses. Personally Identifiable Information such as customer names and e-mail addresses, User Content, and other User information (and Non-Personally Identifiable Information) related to the Service will likely be among the items transferred in these types of transactions. We may also transfer or assign such information in the course of corporate divestitures, mergers, acquisitions, bankruptcies, dissolutions or similar transactions or proceedings. Instances where we are required to share your Personally Identifiable Information: We will disclose Personally Identifiable Information where required to do so by law or subpoena or if we reasonably believe that such action is necessary to (a) comply with the law and the reasonable requests of law enforcement; (b) to enforce our Terms of Service, or to protect the security or integrity of our Service; and/or (c) to exercise or protect the rights, property, or personal safety of PLASCHY MUSIC, our Users or others.

We may share Non-Personally Identifiable Information, including information obtained through tools such as cookies, log files, and clear gifs (such as anonymous usage data, referring/exit pages and URLs, Service types, number of clicks etc.): (i) in any manner permitted for Personally Identifiable Information; and (ii) with our third-party business partners. We may also aggregate or otherwise strip data of all personally identifying characteristics and may share that aggregated, anonymized data with third parties.

Data Retention: We retain your data for as long as your account is active or is needed for providing you with our services. International Transfers: Personally Identifiable Information collected through the Service may be stored and processed in the United States or any other country in which PLASCHY MUSIC or its subsidiaries, affiliates or Service providers maintain facilities. PLASCHY MUSIC may transfer information that we collect about you, including Personally Identifiable Information, to affiliated entities, or to other third parties across borders and from your country or jurisdiction to other countries or jurisdictions around the world. If you are located in the European Union or other regions with laws governing data collection and use that may differ from U.S. law, please note that we may transfer information, including Personally Identifiable Information, to a country and jurisdiction that does not have the same data protection laws as your jurisdiction, and you consent to the transfer of information to the U.S. or any other country in which PLASCHY MUSIC or its subsidiaries, affiliates or Service providers maintain facilities and the use and disclosure of information about you, including Personally Identifiable Information, as described in this Data privacy statement.
